

Diamond Murder

A Sussex antiques dealer was brutally murdered by burglars. The murderers torched the property to eliminate evidence. It took an intervention with Chorus to identify them.

The victim was known to own two diamonds worth £40k.

Roadside clues

- A dog walker remembered a man making a call outside the house
- A black 4x4 was spotted on the pavement

Chorus - challenge

- Evidence destroyed by fire
- 100,000 lines of local cell tower data
- Police couldn't identify suspect's number

Police established that the fire had been started deliberately.



SIM switch

Murderers destroyed their own SIMs but used one from a girlfriend's phone.

Convictions secured

Chorus - Connection Detection

- Chorus led to suspect's girlfriend
- Police find SIM and handset
- ANPR, call and cell site id post-event
- 100 years jail time
