

Serious Crime Definition

- An offence that attracts a prison sentence of at least 12 months
- An offence by a person who is not an individual (i.e. a corporate body)
- Where the conduct involves the use of violence, results in substantial financial gain or is by a large number of persons in pursuit of a common purpose.
- An offence which involves, as an integral part of it, the sending of a communication or breach of a persons privacy
